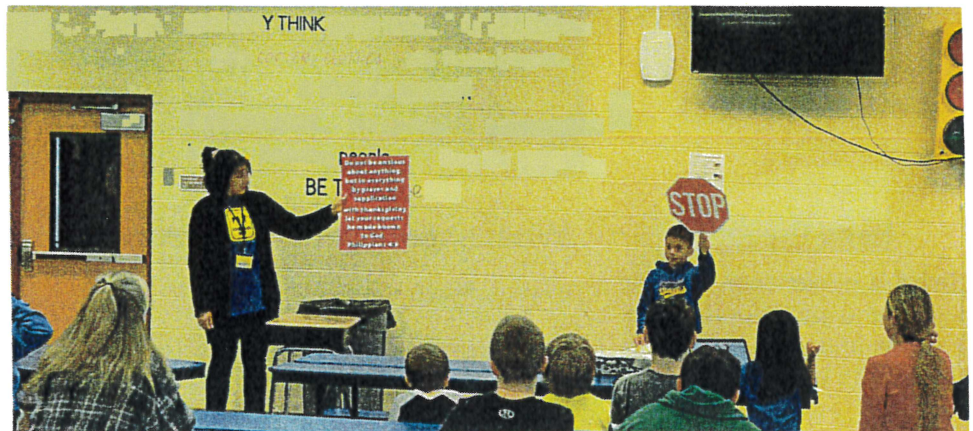

## What is Club Time?

Club time is a fun after-school event, much like a book club where your child will get to ask questions and share thoughts about the story of the week. For children working on reading skills, we provide engaging games and music develop literacy and comprehension. Our text focuses on Jesus' Love for us and God's love for all people. We share the Bible in a fun way so that kids can thoughtfully read what the Bible is saying to them. There's a "WORD UP" for each week that is the main message for the kids. The great news is that clubs are FREE for families. After school programs are made possible by community support. Meeting dates follow the district calendar on full school days. Registration is required to ensure safety, so contact your local leader for permission forms.



## Sample Schedule

Games	Opening Games during check in time.
Small group Time	Kids connect in small groups with their leaders to check in, eat a snack, get to know friends, and receive rewards bringing their own Bible, memory verse, or completing "Quiet Time" for prizes or bringing a new friend!
Opening	We start Club with music, talk about what our "Word Up" is for the day, explain what prayer is.
Bible Lesson	Bible lessons are designed to be engaging with life application questions.
Memory Verse	Here is where we teach kids a verse and help them to memorize it by playing a game or with a song. Punch Cards help kids earn Prizes for trying.
Wonder Time	Occasionally we'll have a demonstration, skit, craft, or extra games to extend the lesson.
Missions	We share inspiring stories of missionaries and the positive impact they've made.
Review Game	Fun review games to make sure kids understand the Bible lesson and what was being taught.
Check Out Time	Only authorized adults permitted to pick up children.
